



Summer Camp Education Intern (Ages 15-22)

The Wortham Center for the Performing Arts seeks a small team of high-school and college-age interns who are excited to gain hands-on experience in the world of theatre education. Summer Camp Interns will work with the Wortham Education Team for four weeks of full and half-day camps running Monday-Friday, June 24 – July 26, for kids ages 6-11.

A Summer Education Internship with Wortham allows aspiring artists and educators the opportunity to...

- Work alongside professional teaching artists.
- Develop leadership, organizational, and interpersonal skills.
- Expand professional network and build relationships and mentorships for the future.
- Hone classroom and management skills.
- Learn flexibility while working with a diverse group of students.
- Gain confidence as an educator, artist, and creative collaborator.

Summer Education Interns are expected to...

- Actively assist teaching artists in camps for students ages 6 – 11.
- Help facilitate daily student drop off and pick up.
- Oversee snack, lunch, and bathroom breaks.
- Support rehearsals and performances by leading breakout rehearsals and working behind the scenes.
- Lead daily warm-ups for students.
- Maintain clean and organized classroom and performance spaces.
- Communicate clearly and respectfully to staff, students, and families.
- Attend a mandatory training session before camps begin, date and time TBD.

All staff members will be required to show proof of full vaccination. All staff members over 18 will be subject to a background and criminal check. Housing is not provided.

Interns will be offered a weekly stipend of \$120 for half-day camps and \$170 for full-day camps.
