



Job Description Café Staff

Wortham Center for Performing Arts, located in downtown Asheville, North Carolina, is seeking part-time Café Staff in our McAninch Café to support our upcoming 2026-27 Season events in the Diana Wortham Theatre, Tina McGuire Theatre, and Henry LaBrun Studio.

Wortham Center for the Performing Arts presents and supports local, regional, and national live performances in an array of disciplines including Dance, Music, Theatre, and Special Events. The McAninch Café serves Wortham Center audiences an assortment of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages including beer, wine, soft drinks, and locally made prepackaged snack options.

Primary Café Staff Duties:

- The Café Staff is responsible for assisting Wortham Center patrons in a friendly and efficient manner in a fast-paced environment.
- Serving food and beverages to Wortham Patrons while observing all Safe-Serve and proper food handling techniques.
- Handling patron orders, totaling orders in our processing system, cash handling, making change, and processing credit card payments.
- Responsible for all Café opening and closing procedures, including cleaning, restocking of Café inventory, and closing sales reports, as well as the set up and breakdown of our Mobile Bar and Concessions.
- The Café Staff is responsible for the overall success of Café sales for all performances and events at the Wortham Center.
- The Café Staff works as a team with the overall Front of House staff here at the Wortham Center.

The McAninch Café is open during the majority of our live performance events. Café Staff must have weekend day and evening availability, with weekday shifts subject to the performance schedule. Café Staff must be 18 years old, have a valid ID and be able to complete the North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission *Responsible Alcohol Seller/Server Training*. Part-time pay rate is \$12 per hour plus tips.
